

MĀTAI WHETŪ MARAE

Ngāti Maru Highway | Kōpū | Thames

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*Ngā tini whetū ki te rangi ~ Ngāti Maru ki te whenua

Marae Rates

- \$50 Bond to secure dates for pre-booking
 - \$400 Overnight Stay (per night)
 - \$200 Day Booking (9am – 5pm)
 - \$50 Linen Hire
- An invoice can be sent with our bank details for direct payment

Wharenuui

- All chairs & stools to be put back when when whānau vacate the marae
- Stools & chairs in the Wharenuui are NOT to be used in the Wharekai
- If linen is used, please count up and leave just inside the Wharenuui
- Wharenuui to be vacuumed after use
- Front of the Wharenuui is to be swept clean

Kauta/Kitchen

- Stoves, fridges & freezer to be cleaned
- Tea-towels are supplied, please leave dirty towels in laundry basket provided
- Benches & sinks to be left clean & tidy
- Floors to be swept & mopped
- If chiller is used, please empty & clean
- Crockery, pots & dishes must remain at the marae, any others will be allocated by the Maraе Custodian
- Please ensure waste is disposed of in the correct bins for disposal:
 - Recycling
 - Rubbish (general waste)
 - Food scraps (pig bucket)

Marae Tikanga

- Mātai Whetū Maraе is a **NO ALCOHOL & NO DRUGS** Maraе
- There are to be no photos or videos taken inside Te Rama O Hauraki (Wharenuui)
- **Disregard of the above may result in the decline of future hire requests**

Tangi / Hura Kōwhatu

- All tangi are supplied with first meal if required
- Mattresses and mats for tangi are in the hallway cupboard
- Two Whāriki/mats for tangi are in the mattress room

Mattress Room

- Mattresses to be stacked tidily
- Pillows to be placed back in cupboard tidily
- Floors to be swept & mopped

Wharekai/Dining Room

- Chairs & tables to be stacked
- Floor to be swept & mopped

Wharepaku/Toilet Area

- Toilets, showers & hand basins to be cleaned
- Rubbish bags to be emptied
- Floors to be swept & mopped/hosed out

We Supply Initial

- Hand towels
- Toilet Rolls
- Rubbish Bags
- Soap
- Small supply of cleaning & washing products
- First cup of tea & snack can be provided after the pōwhiri (whakanoa)
